

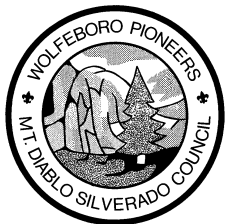
Scouting's 100th Anniversary

To get to St. Luke's Lutheran Church, 2491 San Miguel Drive, Walnut Creek, CA 94596 from north of Walnut Creek, get to Southbound I-680, south of the Calif. 24 intersection. Take the South Main Exit. Turn right (south) on South Main/Danville Blvd. Turn left on Rudgear Road, turn left on San Miguel. The Church will be on the left.

From the South get to I-680 Northbound. Take the Rudgear/South Broadway Exit, turn right on Rudgear Road and left on San Miguel. The church is still on the left.

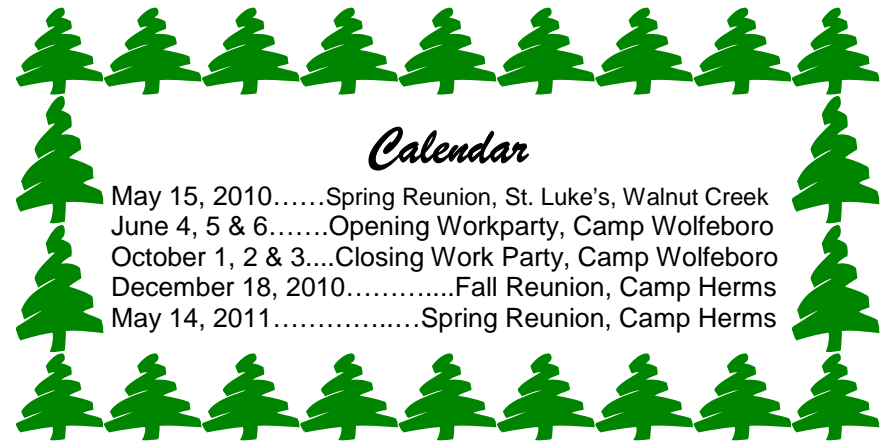
MAJOR PROJECTS PLANNED TO OPEN IN 2010

While that was going on, another project was progressing to replacing the outer wall surfaces of the Dining Hall. Whereas the walls were replaced, not enough time remained to install new "windows", screens and shutters. This will be our major opening project at the Workparty on June 4, 5 & 6. This will be in addition to the other regular opening projects to chase winter away from Sand Flat. If time, weather and labor permit, we may even have a chance to resurface the stage at the Main Campfire Circle.
